Coach's Code of Conduct

Milton Youth Soccer recognizes that coaches are the key representatives of the game of soccer to the kids on their team. Coaches have great influence on their players in development of ability, knowledge, attitude and sportsmanship of the game of soccer. His or her conduct is watched and emulated by players. In the best interests of Milton Youth Soccer players, the following code is expected from all our soccer coaches:

1. Be courteous at all times with players, opponents, game officials and fans.
2. Exercise self control on the field before, during and after contests. There shall be no use of foul and abusive language.
3. Be familiar with the rules of the game, tournament, and league in which you compete.
4. Be a role model of fair play and good sportsmanship.
5. Teach skills and fair tactics. Do not tolerate or encourage unnecessarily rough play.
6. Individual players should be coached positively; failings should not be singled out in front of the team.
7. Respect the integrity and judgement of game officials.
8. There shall be no use of tobacco products, alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs at MYS programs.
